It's was getting even worse after that, I lost my parents, my bigger brothers abandoned me, I've been separated from my younger brother, who I took care. I had to leave my brothers and my country which I loved and was adopted to a family in Holland. When I became 18 years old I had the desire to go back to Korea but somehow Yahweh forbid to do that and sent me to Israel. To me it was a very emotional homecoming! Even though I didn't understand a thing what was going on with me! This visit to Israel was a beginning of my journey to make teshuva to Yahweh Elohim the Melech Israel, which is *also* my Elohim. And in my years of wandering I had received the same revelation of the 2-houses ministry all alone. Yahweh brought me to YATI which is an *Brook of Eliyahu* to me! Baruch Hashem Yahweh, for His great works/ wonders, His chen en rachamim towards Israel, His children.

I wanted share a little of my personal story with you that you might be encouraged! That you know how important the ministry is to so many people out there! Because personally I've no place to go there except to listen to YATI radio.
